

THE 7 P's of the HOLY SPIRIT

During our time of study through Anne's *Jesus In Me*, we're going to address the 7 major P's of the Holy Spirit – The Person, Presence, Power, Purpose, Precepts, Purity, and Priority. We pray you walk away from this study confident in knowing who the Holy Spirit is and the important role He plays in your life.



1. THE PERSON OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

While the Holy Spirit may be symbolized by a dove or flame of fire, while His presence may be accompanied by an emotion or feeling or ecstatic experience, He Himself is distinctly separate from those things. The Holy Spirit is not a thing but a Person.

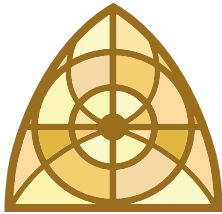
7. THE PRIORITY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

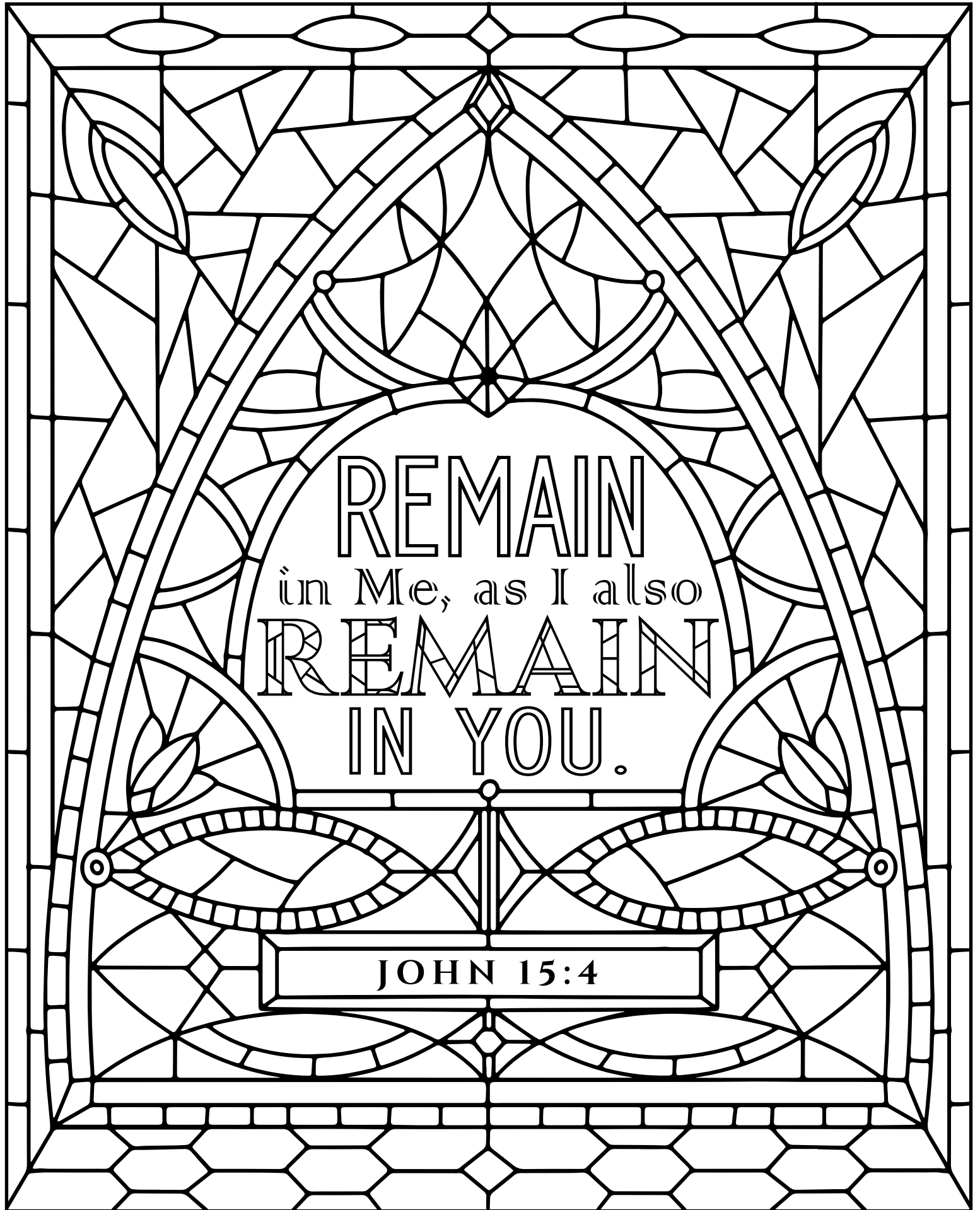
