Significant Events In and Around JESUS' TOMB

CAPERNAUM

The women arrive at the tomb find the stone rolled away. <u>Luke 24:2–9</u>
Mary Magdalene and the other Mary see the angel. <u>Matthew 28:1–8</u>
Peter and John arrive at the tomb, look in, and depart. <u>John 20:3–10</u>
Mary Magdalene sees two angels and then Jesus. <u>John 20:11–18</u>
The risen Christ sends her to inform the disciples. <u>John 20:17–18</u>
The women are met by the risen Christ. <u>Matthew 28:9–10</u>



Cornelius has a vison and sends men to Joppa to find Peter. Acts 10:1–48
Paul lands in Caesarea after his second missionary journey. Acts 18:22
Paul visits Philip the Evangelist after his third missionary journey. Acts 21:8–9
Agabus prophesizes that Paul will be handed over to the Romans. Acts 21:10–11
Paul is arrested and taken to Governor Felix. Acts 23:23–24
Paul is imprisoned in Caesarea for two years. Acts 24:27
Paul appears before Governor Festus. Acts 25:6–7
Paul appears before King Agrippa and Bernice. Acts 25:23
Paul boards a ship headed for Rome. Acts 27:1–2
